WHAT DO YOU NEED?

- Personal information (e.g. id number)
- Details of your education (past and future exams, including entrance exams)
- School / Program choices
- Teacher's Reference
- Predicted grade
- Personal Statement (4000 character / 47 line essay)

WHAT SCORE DO I NEED?

- 32: Lowest score you would want
- 32-35: More options
- 36-38: Comfortable, good score
- 38-40: Great score that exceeds almost all uni requirements
- 40 or above: Competitive score for G5 + KCL

- *Higher levels are always more heavily weighted

ENGINEERING

International Baccalaureate

35 points overall with 6,6,5 in Higher Level subjects.

The course specific requirements are: 35 points overall with 6, 6, 5 at Higher level in Mathematics, Physics and one other subject.

We also accept 5 in English Language at Standard level to meet our English language requirements.

Minimum entry standards

Our minimum entry standard for 2021 entry is **40 points overall**, to include:

- 6 in Mathematics at higher level
- 6 in Physics at higher level
- 6 in another subject at higher level

International Baccalaureate Diploma Standard offer

38 points overall with 18 at Higher Level, including 7, 6 (in any order) at Higher Level in Mathematics (either Analysis and Approaches or Applications and Interpretations) and any one of Physics, Chemistry, Further Mathematics or Computer Science
