# STEM Investigations with Flying Colours – Recognition of Students’ Multiple Intelligences

Being engaged in the Hong Kong Student Science Project Competition (HKSSPC) in August 2021, 29 G.T. students from G7 to G10 have been soaring high in demonstrating their multiple intelligences through a number of diversified STEM investigations. 11 projects were guided and supported by Dr. Molly Chan and her team. During the preparation of the competition, students have learnt about experimental design, data analysis, intellectual property and presentation skills. Calista Loh’s (9B) project, “Male Contraceptive Pills: A Step Nearer to Gender Equality?”, and Hei Lam Yue’s (7A) project, “Enzymatic Recycling of Plastic for a Circular Economy?”, won two First Prizes in the Scientific Wallchart Division. The HKSSPC learning journey has been a wonderful experience for G.T. students to gain opportunities to further explore their strengths and interests.


