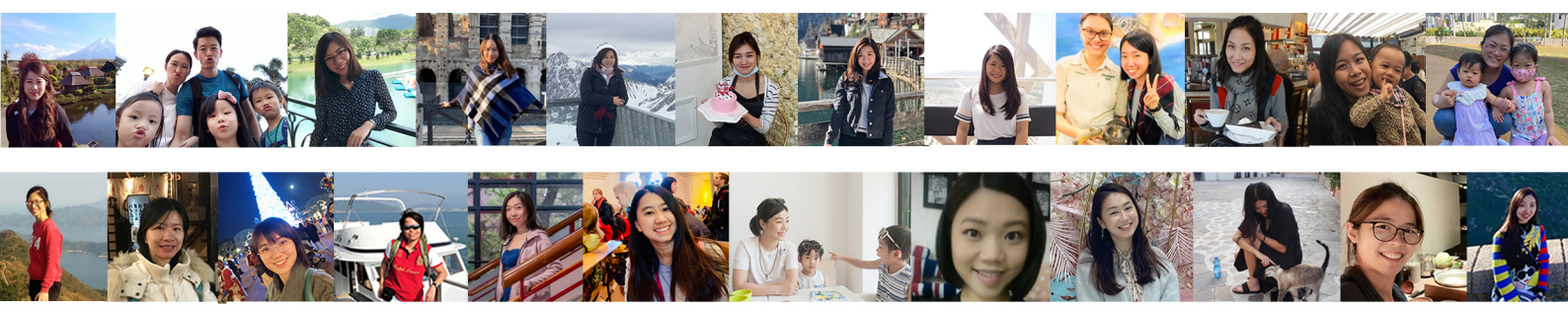

English Language Panel Head (Senior Form)

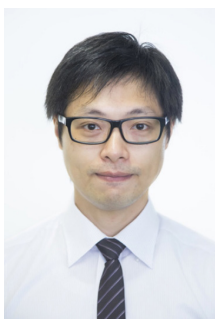

Vice Head of Talent Development Group, Head of Elective Day, Liberal Studies Teacher, Class Teacher of 10B

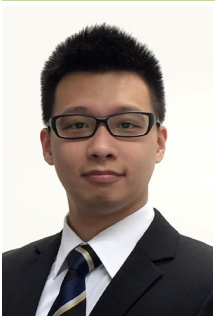

Mathematics and Physics Teacher, Class Teacher of 7A

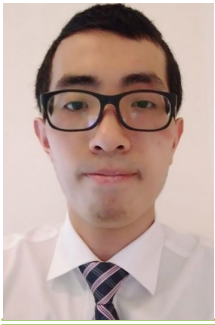

English Language Teacher, Class Teacher of 8A

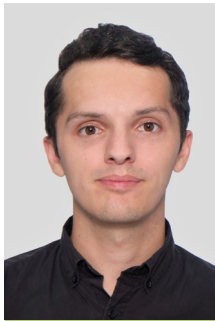

Laboratory Technician — Biology and Chemistry

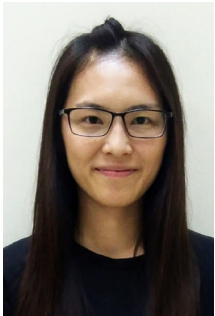

School Social Worker

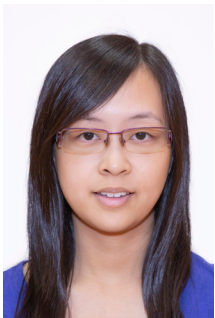
