It was our great honour to have Prof. Henry Nai Ching Wong, Emeritus Professor of Chemistry at The Chinese University of Hong Kong and Founding Member of the Hong Kong Academy of Sciences as the Guest of Honour of the STEM forum. 
Picnic Day
