Professor King L. CHOW

School Board Chairman

Professor Chow is an accomplished university administrator and educator. He received his PhD in Cell Biology from Baylor College of Medicine. His own research focuses on molecular genetics, neural development, synthetic and evolutionary biology on diverse model organisms. He has researched extensively in a variety of areas of pedagogy including exploratory project course, MOOC and extensive flipped classes, and was awarded the Science School of Teaching Award and the Michael G. Gale Medal of distinguished teaching at HKUST. He also heads the Center for Development of the Gifted and Talented in UST.

Professor Chow has served as the Academic Director of the Common Core Program and the Director of Interdisciplinary Programs Office, and is currently serving as the Dean of Students.

Chemistry Teacher

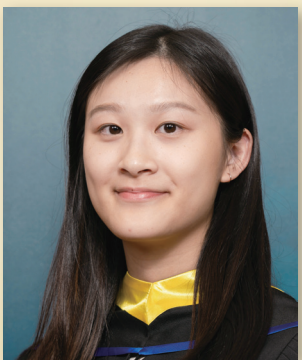

School Social Worker

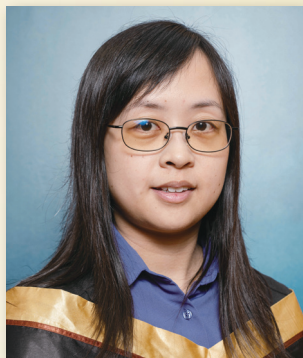
